 Judge: Dressage: Linda Strine Stadium: Barbara Hoopes
 Attire: Casual & tidy with hard-soled shoes. Helmet required when mounted. Safety vest & medical armband or **medical bracelet** required for cross country course. No standing martingales. Whips allowed. **Dressage legal bits only!** Consult USEA/USDF rulebook for current legal issues. **THERE HAVE BEEN CHANGES TO THE BITTING RULES.**

Concession: Lunch & drinks both days provided by Winners Circle.

Dogs: Must be friendly and kept on a leash.

Stabling: \$60 weekend (Fri-Sun), Grounds Fee: \$15 (if not stabled); Shavings: \$8 per bag.

Tack stalls: \$25 each. RV hookups: \$30 weekend.

(XC Schooling only day stall (Sunday) = \$10 per stall)

Prizes: Ribbons for overall (CT & HT); Special awards & prizes.

Refunds: NO REFUNDS after the closing date.

Entries: Same horse may be shown in two different divisions (either HT/CT) with different riders, but you must fill out **separate** entry forms. You don't have to show to school XC course on Sunday. **Late/incomplete entries AND any change to entry will be charged \$25 - no exceptions!!!! AND may be subject to a waitlist if entries warrant.**
